- 👕 **Synthetic Reliance:** Around 60% to 70% of fast fashion materials consist of cheap, non-biodegradable polyester and synthetics.
- ♻️ **The Linear Trap:** Rigid "take-make-dispose" routines that quickly accelerate global textile landfill overflow.



The Human Cost Behind the Price Tag

-  **Labor Exploitation:** Heavy dependence on low-cost labor forces in developing regions to sustain ultra-low retail pricing.
-  **Underpaid Workforces:** Only a tiny fraction of garment workers receive a reliable living wage to cover baseline living costs.
-  **Systemic Pressure:** Intense production quotas and rapid timelines frequently result in unsafe, high-stress conditions.

Tasks that once demanded tedious manual sorting are now handled rapidly by automated production lines.

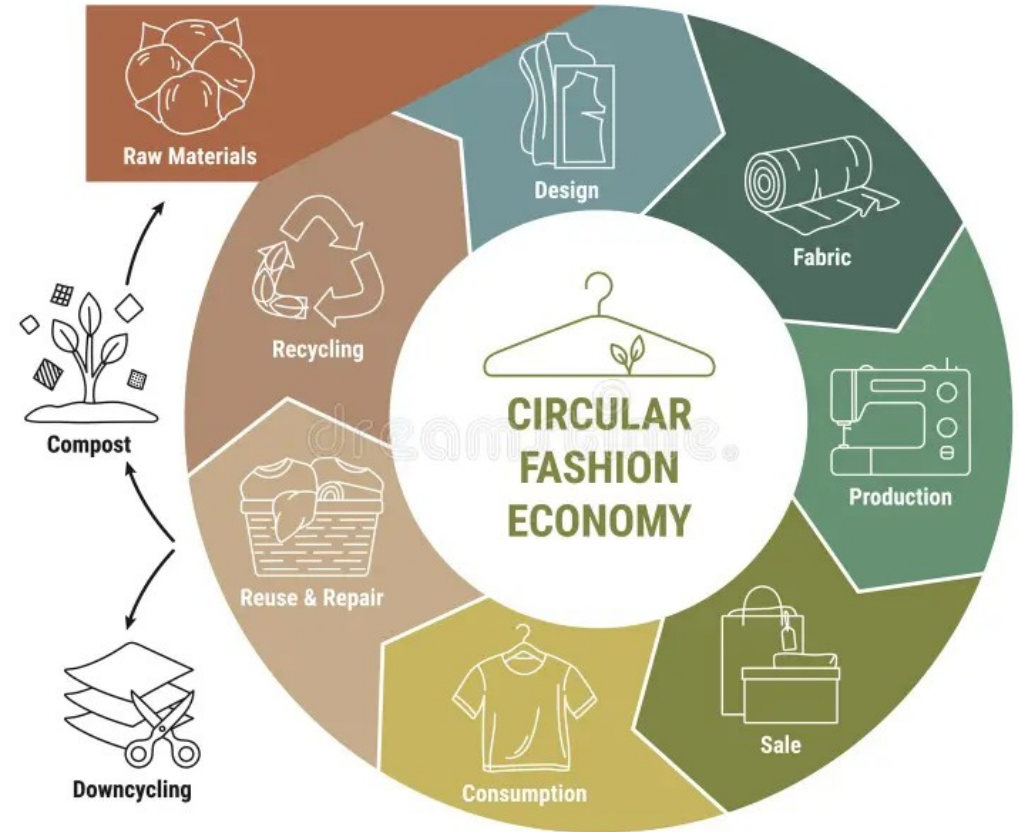
