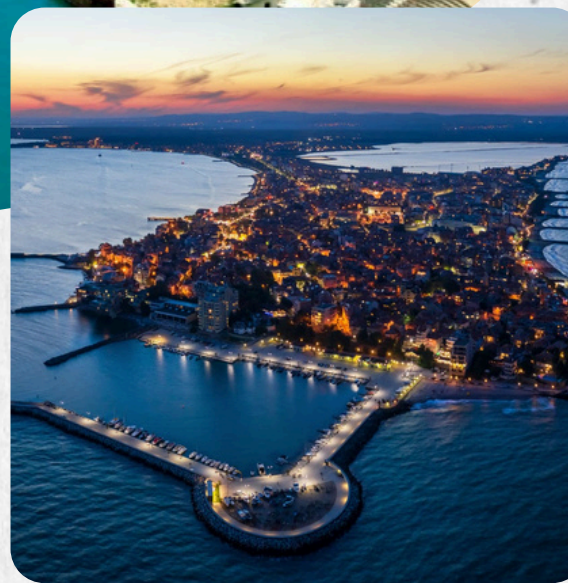

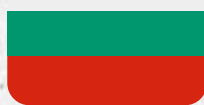

PROJECT OBJECTIVES



Social entrepreneurship can have great potential to mobilize youth to engage in efforts to achieve significant social objectives, including employment creation, poverty reduction, inclusion, and integration. Dedicated to serving the common good, social enterprises established by young people can directly contribute to achieving several Sustainable Development Goals. SociallyAgile promotes social entrepreneurship through an innovative approach and is structured for young people with the objective to get introduced to business concepts, understand how to implement an innovative idea in the field of social entrepreneurship, be trained and mentored and, finally launch their start-up

- Accumulate ideas, Create a support network and exchange experiences among the participants



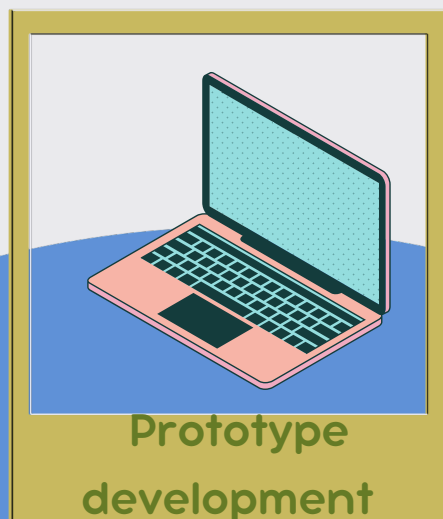

What You Need To Know

- **Tolerance and Cooperation:** You need to be tolerant, follow all instructions from the volunteers and organizers from the Academy, and always be open to dialogue and reaching agreements.
- **Extended Stay:** You can stay in Bulgaria for up to two days after the end of the project at your own expense.
- **Travel Expense Reimbursement:** It is mandatory to keep all bus tickets, train tickets, or fuel receipts to be reimbursed for your travel expenses. Travel expenses will be reimbursed during the project, only after presenting all necessary documents.
- **Covered Costs:** All project-related expenses are covered by the European Commission.
- **Respect and Adherence to Rules:** Ensure you respect all participants and adhere to the project's rules and guidelines throughout your stay.

PARTICIPANT AGREEMENT

A learning agreement will be established between facilitators and participants.



This agreement establishes commitments and roles for all participants, ensuring awareness of the project's objectives, attendance at all sessions, workshops, and relevant activities, utilization of the Youthpass for assessing their learning and finally with a dissemination of what have learnt.

During the project's various sessions, facilitators will encourage participants to collaborate in small groups to develop a set of rules and expectations for the upcoming 10 days, fostering a sense of equality between participants and facilitators.

Recognizing the significance of discussions, evaluation processes, and self-assessment, we will actively engage in group discussions to reflect on daily successes and challenges, allowing participants to propose solutions or suggestions.

The evaluation and assessment process will be a collaborative effort between facilitators and participants, focusing on working methods and group dynamics to meet the participants' needs and achieve the project's objectives.



Sunny Beach (Bulgarian: Слънчев бряг, Slanchev bryag) is a seaside resort on the Black Sea coast of Bulgaria, 35 km (22 mi) north of Burgas and 94 km (58 mi) south of Varna.

Created in 1958 as a weekend getaway for Bulgarian families, Sunny Beach has become the largest tourist and vacation spot in the country. Today, The Bulgarian resort of Sunny Beach has been recognised in the prestigious ranking of the 100 best beaches in the world. This ranking is based on the votes of tourism influencers and travel experts who identified the most attractive beaches for the Golden Beach 2024 award.

The beach in Sunny Beach was ranked 84th, ahead of global destinations such as Varadero/Cuba, Bavaro/Dominican Republic and Love Beach in the Bahamas. This shows that this beach attracts the attention of not only locals but also tourists from all over the world.

Its rapid growth makes it the largest resort on the entire Black Sea coast; to the south, the complex has merged with the town of Nesebar.



Accommodation

Grand Kamelia Holiday Complex



"Camellia Garden" is an amazing complex, occupying a central position in the Sunny Beach resort.

Just a 7-minute walk from the seashore and picturesque beach, and 8 minutes from the city center. Near the complex there is all the necessary social and resort infrastructure, such as shops, supermarkets, restaurants, cafes, a medical center and bus stops. The historical town of Nessebar is located 3 km from the complex.



Rooms will be shared between 3 -4 people.

Breakfast, lunch and dinner will be served in the accommodation, as well as near by restaurants. Two coffee pauses per day will be provided

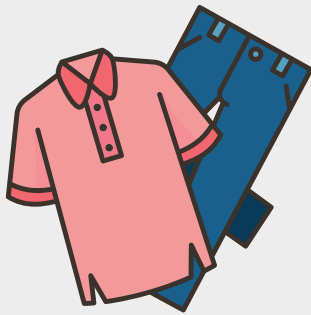

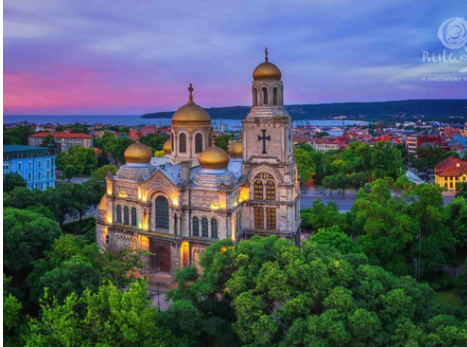

HOW TO ARRIVE



ARRIVING TO VARNA

Once you arrive to Varna you need to head to Central Bus Station, next to Grand Mall, bld Vladislav Varnenchik 158. There is a direct bus line

ARRIVING TO BOURGAS

There is a direct bus departing from Burgas South and arriving at Sunny Beach. Services depart hourly, and operate every day. The journey takes approximately 1h 10m.

REIMBURSEMENT

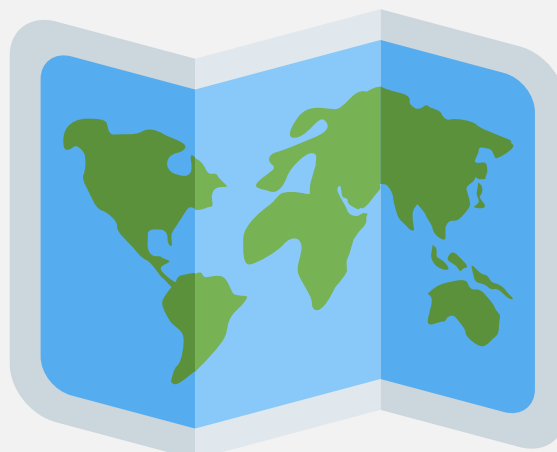
